9. Executive Director Report:

- A. <u>Directives</u> Ms. Stir reported that the March 2016 board meeting directives have been completed.
- B. <u>Fiscal Reports</u> Quarter 3 FY16 reports were provided to the board members. There were no concerns voiced.
- C. <u>MBE/EDGE Update</u> Ms. Stir reported that the Board is currently meeting the 15% requirement for MBE (36.89%) and the 5% EDGE (12%) statutory requirements.
- D. <u>E-Licensing</u> Ms. Stir reported that veterinary renewal was more challenging this year due to the E-Licensing state system issues. The system was not accessible for a few days and then several of the systems' features were disabled. The Board staff immediately placed the renewal forms on the Board web site and instructed licensees who were experiencing difficulties to send the renewal application by mail. The Board is scheduled to be phased into the new system in late 2017. The cost for the new system has not yet been determined.

Ms. Stir is also to place a notice on the Board's web site that the board will be reviewing Rule 4741-1-21 along with the other rules being considered for their 2017 five year review. The Board members will begin reviewing the five year review rules this summer.
