8. **OVMA Liaison:** Jack Advent provided feedback on recommended changes to the initial rule draft.

10. Executive Director Report:

- A. Directives – The June Board meeting Directives have been completed.
- B. Criminal Offense Research – Members were provided copies of a couple other state agency licensure requirements related to previous criminal offenses. Members were also asked to review specific sections of the Veterinary Practice Act. The Board will consider modifying specific rules that will be reviewed for filing in 2014 to mirror the statutory language.
- C. Rule Development - Members were provided the rules that will be included in the five year review: Rules 4741-1-01, 4741-1-03, 4741-1-04, 4741-1-08, 4741-1-10, 4741-1-14, 4741-1-23, 4741-2-02, 4741-2-03, 4741-2-04, 4741-3-01, 4741-3-02, 4741-3-03, 4741-3-04, 4741-3-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Additionally, the Board members revised the companion animal vaccination clinic and home visit rules to reflect the agreed to recommendations of OVMA.
- D. Legislative Update – Sub HB 116, the Chemical Capture Bill, was voted out of the House on June 12, 2013. HB 98 requires rules to be written by each licensing board regarding what military experience the Board members determine will be acceptable in lieu of educational requirements for licensure. The Board members did not see that rules would be applicable to the OVMLB as there is no discretion in the educational requirements and testing required in the law.
- E. Annual Report – The Annual Report for FY13 was completed and reviewed by the Board for approval. Dr. Dass signed the letters to accompany the Annual report to be submitted to the Governor's office, Secretary of State and to the State Library. The Report will be posted on the Board's web site.




