**8. OVMA Liaison:** Jack Advent, Director of the Ohio Veterinary Medical Association, updated the Board on recent projects. The OVMA has been working on putting together a Prescription Drug Taskforce to help facilitate communication & education between Veterinarians and Pharmacists as well as taking a bigger look at wellness in Veterinary Medicine. The OVMA is working with the Pharmacy Board to take a look at the compounded drugs law as it relates to Veterinary medicine. Jack also gave an Update on the ODH radiology Rule.

**9. Executive Director Report:**

- A. Directives – The Directives for the October 2014 have been completed. Due to lack of quorum, there was no November board meeting.
- B. Governor's Appointments - No report.
- C. Rules - The public rule hearing for OAC 4741-1-18 as filed was held this morning without any opponent or proponent testimony. The JCARR hearing is Monday, December 15, 2014. Rule 4741-4-04 OAC will be refiled as JCARR asked that a modification be made to include the effective dates of the federal laws mentioned in the rule. The public rule hearing for Rule 4741-4-04 OAC will be held in March, 2015.
- D. Inactive Licenses– According to ORC 4741.16(C), a license that is not renewed at the end of a biennium becomes an inactive license. A licensee can reactivate an inactive license upon application to the Board. A license that has been inactive for more than four years expires and the applicant must reapply as if an initial license. The practice of the Board has been that if someone who has been practicing out of state wishes to reactivate their license within the four years, they must pay the \$155 renewal fee PLUS the late fee of \$295 AND submit 30 hours of CE. (i.e. if the veterinarian left Ohio in 2012 and did not renew in 2012, came back to practice in October, 2014, the veterinarian must submit a fee of \$900.00 and 60 hours of CE for two renewal period). The Board decided that submitting payment for one renewal cycle, CE submission and a Letter of Good Standing from the state where the veterinarian was practicing would suffice.
- E. Newsletter – The Board reviewed the 2014-2015 Newsletter which will be emailed to the listserv.

- F. Anti-Discrimination Training – The Board staff have completed the required Employee Anti-Discrimination and Anti-Harassment training.

A. OEHA – ORC 4741 & OAC 4741-1-16 regarding exempting public health vaccination clinics. The Board directed Ms. Stir to send the same reply that was provided to Mr. Socrates Tuch, Legal Counsel for the Ohio Department of Health. After careful review of the law and rules, there is nothing in the law that exempts public entities from the Veterinary Medical Practice Act, other than the Ohio Department of Agriculture. The Board members determined that the state, county, and local health departments will be required to abide by the terms set forth in Rule 4741-1-16 of the Ohio Administrative Code. A notice has been placed on the Board’s web site as well as in its annual newsletter.

B. Kim Cook, DVM – Zoo Internship & Limited Lic. After review of the law and rules, the Board members determined that the international interns would still need to have a limited license and would have to be affiliated with the veterinary college. The members suggested that the zoo make arrangements with the Ohio State University College of Veterinary Medicine or another AVMA accredited program.

C. Carol Krompacky, DVM OAC 4741-1-16 regarding clarification of the term “discharge” in the Vaccination Clinic rule. The Board’s response regarding “discharge” is that once the owner is in complete control of the animal once services have been rendered, the animal is discharged. Payment of services is not considered part of the vaccination rule.


