Especially the fact that HB 509 eliminated the ability for an RVT to renew after March 1<sup>st</sup>. The Board directed Ms. Stir to attempt to have the current language reinstated by working with the legislature and to insert request in the House testimony before the Finance Committee. Rules, Elicense and the website will all require modifications. An update on the budget bill was also provided. The Board directed Ms. Stir to request that the Student loan appropriation be returned to \$30,000.


