## MEETING MINUTES June 13, 2012

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### 1. Call to Order:

### 3. Acknowledge Staff, AAG & Guests:

Dr. Kolb acknowledged the attendance of Theresa Stir, Executive Director, Barry McKew, Assistant Attorney General, Joseph McClain, Licensure Coordinator taking board minutes and guests in attendance.

8. **OVMA Liaison:** Jack Advent spoke on the OVMA stance on the record keeping rule. OVMA feels the current record keeping rule is sufficient. Mr. Advent also informed the Board members that since the Exotic Animal bill passed, that OVMA is working on resources for those people who own and care for exotic animals.

## 10. Executive Director Report: delusional

- A. Directives - All directives were completed, except for the filing of the rules.
- B. Rules – Ms. Jessen moved to file the rules as proposed without any additional changes. Dr. Dass seconded the motion. The motion passed by the following roll call vote: Dr. Redman – aye, Ms. Jessen – aye, Dr. Dass – aye, Dr. Kolb – aye.
- C. Board Appointments – There was no update to provide. Phone calls and emails have not been responded to by the Boards and Commissions office of the Governor.
- D. Provisional License – Ms. Stir sought clarification regarding the issuing of provisional licenses to new graduates who have not passed the NAVLE. The Board determined that in reading Section 4741.15 ORC, the law does not take effect until the candidate actually graduates, therefore the taking of NAVLE prior to graduation should not count against the individual. Ms. Jessen moved to issue the provisional license to the candidate applying for provisional license once the application was complete. Dr. Dass seconded the motion. - E. Monitoring Update – Ms. Stir reported that the Board currently has 8 individuals being monitored as a result of Settlement Agreement terms. The practitioners include: 3 individuals (2 veterinarians and 1 RVT) are enrolled in the OPHP program with varying probationary and practice restriction terms; one whose 5 year probation ends in November 2012; One who is currently taking their suspension time, but has already complied with all other requirements of the Settlement Agreement; 3 submitting quarterly records and one who is awaiting adjudication for a Settlement Agreement violation.




