### 3. Acknowledge Staff, AAG & Guests:

Dr. Kidd acknowledged the attendance of Theresa Stir, Executive Director, Barry McKew, Assistant Attorney General, Joseph McClain, Licensure Coordinator taking board minutes.

**7. AAVSB Presentation:** Jim Penrod executive director of the AAVSB provided a presentation to the Board about services offered by the AAVSB, strategy for dealing with key issues, and future goals.

8. **OVMA Liaison:** Jack Advent executive director of the OVMA provided an update on current Pharmacy Board legislation as it relates to veterinarians.

9. **Executive Director Report:**

- A. Directives – Ms. Stir reported that the Board Directives from the April 2016 board meeting have been completed.
- B. Rules – The two versions of Draft Rule 4741-1-21 OAC, along with OVMA’s response and recommendations were provided to the Board members. After discussing, the Board determined to not include the “Closure of a veterinary business” paragraph in this rule as the Guidance on the Board web site was sufficient. Ms. Stir will rewrite the draft version with the recommendations provided during the meeting and distribute to the Board members and interested parties prior to the June board meeting. Additionally, Ms. Stir is to research how other jurisdictions deal with the maintenance of records for horses.
- C. Monitoring Report – Ms. Stir provided an update on the monitoring status of licensees under a settlement agreement or adjudication order.
- D. LEAN Ohio – The Board staff will be participating in LEAN Ohio to review the licensing process. The purpose of the LEAN Ohio is to streamline licensing processes in order to reduce red tape, increase efficiency, boost customer satisfaction, and set the stage for the new licensing implementation for the Board. The “Event” will occur May 24 through the 26<sup>th</sup> which will necessitate closing the Board office for staff training on those days.
- E. Legislation –
  - a. The legislative fix to restore the requirement of passage of the NAVLE for initial licensure in the Veterinary Medical Practice Act is contained in HB 547 which is currently in the House Finance Committee.
  - b. SB 319, which is meant to address the Opioid epidemic, is currently being heard in the Senate Health and Human Services Committee. The Board has been asked to submit a Letter of Support for this legislation. The Board will provide information on the Board’s web site and disseminate information, but will remain neutral regarding the legislation.
- F. Student Loans – The Board received 2 applications for the student loan program. The Board has approximately \$40,898 in the Fund, but has spending authority for \$30,000. The Board awarded \$10,000 each for a one year veterinary practice commitment to: Dr. Sabrina Featheringill of Tiffin and Dr. Luke Morrow of Sugarcreek.
- G. AAVSB Delegate – Mr. Heston moved to appoint Dr. Riker Brown as the Ohio Delegate for the AAVSB conference held in September, 2016. Dr. Kolb seconded the motion. 
