MEETING MINUTES November 09, 2023

Rules Hearing: Beginning at 8:30 a.m. a public rules hearing was held regarding Rules 4741-1-01, 4741-1-04, 4741-1-11, 4741-1-16, 4741-1-17, 4741-1-20, 4741-1-23, 4741-3-02, 4741-3-01, 4741-3-05, 4741-4-05, of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). There was no interested party testimony. The Rules will proceed as filed.

Adjudication Hearing: Case #23-23-052 *OVMLB vs Barry Long, DVM*

Ms. Mills, Assistant Attorney General (AAG) presented the Goldman Hearing case against Dr. Barry Long before the board members via written affidavit and documents with a court reporter in attendance. Dr. Long was notified of the hearing in accordance with ORC 119, but was not present for the hearing.

Dr. O'Connor announces that the Hearing back in public session at 10:00 a.m.

In the matter of Barry Long, VET.2668, Case #23-23-052, Dr. O'Connor moved that the Findings were true and accurate and that Dr. Long violated the codes as outlined in the Notice of Opportunity issued to him. Therefore, the Board orders via an Adjudication Order:

1. That Dr. Long's license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Ohio be suspended for a period of two weeks (ten business days). The suspension shall be taken within sixty (60) days of receipt of the Adjudication Order. Dr. Long's shall notify the Board of the dates of the suspension for Board approval; and
2. Dr. Long's will pay a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1000).
