- B. Fall Newsletter- The revised newsletter was presented to the Board for approval prior to sending out to all licensees and posting on the Board web site.
- C. OhioPHP – The Board members were provided a copy of the OhioPHP model rule regarding “safe haven” along with the OVMLB statute and rule regarding impairment/well being. Jennifer Hayhurst, from OhioPHP, was in attendance to assist with questions. After much discussion, the Board members were in agreement to move forward with a draft of the rule to be considered at a future board meeting.
- D. Settlement Agreement with NOH- Board members reviewed the draft Notice of Opportunity for a Hearing (NOH) with the settlement agreement option. The Board agreed to move forward with this initiative.
- E. Inquiry regarding unapproved drugs to treat FIP – The inquiry related to the treatment of FIP in cats utilizing non-approved anti-viral meds obtained through the internet. The Board members agreed that those drugs can be effective, however, the FDA has only approved the drugs for humans. Therefore, the Board cannot provide any other guidance as the utilization by a veterinarian would be a violation of the Veterinary Practice Act as well as the Pharmacy Board law and rules.
