

Limited or Limited Resident Application Requirements

You must meet the following requirements to receive an Ohio veterinary license. If you do not meet the following requirements within six (6) months of the Board receiving your application, your application will be considered incomplete. Please note: your application fee still remains non-refundable. You will be required to resubmit your application and application fee once you have met all requirements.

- You must submit a letter from the accredited veterinary college, program of veterinary technology or governmental laboratory indicating your employment/internship status.
- Submit a fee: \$155.00 = Limited License \$35.00 = Limited Resident License (can not be renewed). All applications will be charged a \$3.50 transaction fee as well.
- You must provide a picture of yourself. Any picture where your face can be clearly seen is acceptable.
- You must complete both an Ohio criminal background check and an FBI criminal background check, conducted by the Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI). The results must be forwarded to the Ohio Board directly from BCI. - You must provide official court documentation and a written statement explaining criminal charges if applicable.
