

Breakdown of CE Rule [4741-1-11 OAC](#)

<b>Veterinarians</b> - Required to have 30 hours of Continuing Education for Renewal – 20 hours <b>must</b> be scientific (medical) and 10 hours <b>can be</b> non-medical. All 30 hours could be medical CE. First renewals, after graduation, are exempt from the CE requirement.			
<b>Live conference</b>	Can be all 30	But at least 22 hours	
<b>Online course</b>	Can only be 6 hrs of 30	6 hours can be all scientific or four hours medical and 2 hours non-medical	No more than 2 hours can be non-medical
<b>Journal Readings</b>	2 hours of non-medical hours can be Journal readings		
<b>Medical CE</b>	Can be obtained from national, state, and local seminars; programs, meetings, laboratory, course studies or online courses (not to exceed 6 hours)		
<b>Non Medical CE (Examples: practice management, regulations, medical records, equipment training, ethics or communication)</b>	Can be obtained from national, state and local seminars, programs, meetings, laboratory, course studies, professional journals (not to exceed 2 hours) and online courses (not to exceed 2 hours)		

<b>Registered Veterinary Technicians</b> – Required to have 10 hours of Continuing Education for Renewal – 6 hours <b>must</b> be scientific (medical) and 4 hours <b>can be</b> non-scientific (non-medical). All 10 hours can be medical CE. First renewals, after graduation, are exempt from the CE requirement.			
<b>Live conference</b>	Can be all 10	But at least 4 hours	
<b>Online course</b>	Can be 6 hrs of the 10	6 hours can be all scientific or four hours medical and 2 hours non-medical	No more than 2 hours can be non-medical
<b>Journal Readings</b>	2 hours of non-medical hours can be Journal readings		
<b>Medical CE</b>	Can be obtained from national, state, and local seminars; programs, meetings, laboratory, course studies or online courses (not to exceed 6 hours)		
<b>Non Medical CE (Examples: Ethics, Communication, regulations, medical records, equipment training)</b>	Can be obtained from national, state and local seminars, programs, meetings, laboratory, course studies, professional journals (not to exceed 2 hours) and online courses (not to exceed 2 hours)
