## MEETING MINUTES March 14, 2012

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- **Call to Order:**

Dr. Timothy Kolb, President of the Ohio Veterinary Medical Licensing Board called the March 14, 2012 meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. in room 1908 located at 77 South High Street, 19<sup>th</sup> Floor, Columbus, Ohio.

- **Acknowledge Staff, AAG & Guests:**

Dr. Kolb acknowledged the attendance of Theresa Stir, Executive Director, Barry McKew, Assistant Attorney General, Joseph McClain, Licensure Coordinator taking board minutes and guest, John Izzo, attorney at law and Jack Advent, Executive Director of the Ohio Veterinary Medical Association (OVMA).

- **January 2012 Minutes Approved:** Ms. Jessen moved to approve the January 2012 board minutes with corrections. Dr. Dass seconded the motion. The motion passed by the following roll call vote: Dr. Redman – aye, Ms. Jessen – aye, Dr. Dass – aye, Dr. Kolb – aye.
- **President's Report:** Dr. Kolb complimented Ms. Jessen on how well she did speaking at the OVMA conference and was very happy with the attendance. Dr. Kolb reported that Ms. Stir and he were speaking to the third year OSU veterinary students the following day.
- **Vice President's Report:** None
- **Secretary's Report:** None
- **OVMA Liaison:**

1. **Wellness/Vaccination clinic:** Jack Advent the Executive Director of the OVMA addressed the Board with question about vaccination clinics/satellite offices. The issue being, when a veterinarian is going into another facility, that is NOT a veterinary facility, to perform wellness checks and provide vaccinations, what rules and standards apply? Does the individual follow the standards of Rule 4741-1-03 OAC (stationary clinic) or even 4741-1-08 OAC (mobile clinic)? In reviewing the law and rules of the Veterinary Medical Practice Act, the Board did not feel there was any room to deviate from the specifications of the aforementioned rules. Therefore, all standards of Rule 4741-1-03 OAC apply.
2. **Office Closures:** Discussion had been held previously by the Board on how to deal with sudden office closures. Mr. Advent presented that having structured rules related to this issue would be concerning as it could lead to discipline when the situation may not be under a veterinarian's control. The Board decided that a board guideline or recommendations would be more appropriate. Mr. Advent indicated that the OVMA would be happy to work with the Board in drafting a workable guideline.
3. **RVT's responsibility with medical records:** It was determined that since RVTs work at the direction of a veterinarian, the veterinarian is ultimately responsible for what is maintained in the medical record. Therefore it was not necessary at this time to amend Rule 4741-1-21 OAC regarding the inclusion of RVTs.

- **Executive Director Report:**

- A. Directives - The January board meeting directives have been completed except for sending the nomination letter to AAUSB. The letter is ready for Dr. Kolb's signature at the meeting.
- B. Rules – Dr. Kolb suggested a revision to Rule 4741-1-21 (B) to add “and administered” at the end of the paragraph. All members were in agreement. Additionally, as a result of discussion on the vaccination clinics, a suggestion was made to modify Rule 4741-1-22 to the words, “including those” after vaccination clinic, so that ALL vaccination records are maintained for a period of three years, not just those sponsored by city or general health districts. A proposal was made to Rule 4741-2-01 OAC to add “renew” in paragraph (D) and delete “knowing” in (D)(1). The proposed amended rules will be submitted to the Board members at their April meeting as well as the OVMA and OAVT for feedback.
- C. Legislator Issue –Board members were updated of a phone call from Representative Roland Winburn (D) of Dayton regarding a conversation he had with a previous complainant and the disposition of her case.
- D. Board Appointments – No report.
- E. Student Loan Report – The Annual report that is mandated to be sent to the Governor and the general assembly (Section 4741.47 ORC) describing the operations of the veterinarian loan repayment program during 2011 was provided.
- F. Meetings – The Executive Director attended a seminar on Records Management Compliance, and E-Discovery; Central Service Agency, the division of the Ohio Department

of Administrative Services that handles the Board's human resources and fiscal services is holding monthly meetings for the remainder of the fiscal year; Monthly Board & Commission meetings are held. Recently a representative from the State Auditor's office discussed the Directive from the Auditor regarding "Best Practices for Responding to Public Records Requests" which the OVMLB had already implemented. A sample copy of the public records log was provided.


