- A. Directives – The July 2014 Board meeting directives have been completed, except for 2 ongoing projects: Compliance Inspection form revision and the research for certification of animal massage therapy and equine dentistry.
- B. Update - The Board staff completed a record retention project for all licensure files of pulling all old renewal CE documents previous to the 2012 renewal in order to free up file cabinet space. The Executive Director is also updating the procedure manual.
- C. Fiscal Update – The budget preparation for FY 16 & 17 has begun. The Board is permitted to seek 100% of the allotted budget provided in FY 14&15. As previously discussed, the Board is seeking additional funds to cover the costs of increased investigations and compliance inspections, increased rent, and the new state licensure software system. Additionally, as previously approved by the Board members, the Board is submitting statutory language to eliminate the Board’s approval of NAVLE applicants, increasing the initial licensure fee so that all initial licenses are the same and recognizing PAVE as an alternate test provider for foreign graduates.
- D. Rules – The proposed rules have been posted on the Board web site and provided to OVMA. The Business Impact Assessment will be initiated, filed with the Lt. Governor’s Common Sense Initiative Office and posted on the Board’s web site for feedback.

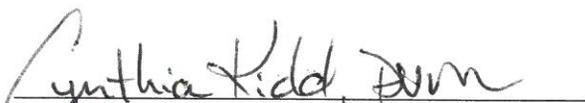
